
NEW FUTURO HEALTH PROGRAM: Pharmacy Technician

Futuro Health programs are a great opportunity for someone who is ready to start school and committed to joining the healthcare workforce.





Pharmacy Technician is a career with a bright future; expected to grow 13% by 2028 just in California.

Pharmacy Technicians work under the direct supervision of a pharmacist and conduct basic, repetitive activities to prepare prescription medicines for patients, such as counting pills, putting medicines in containers, labeling, and packing, after a pharmacist checks a doctor's prescription for errors or potential problems. They are also responsible for keeping track of inventory, ordering when supplies are low, and stocking shelves.

Our Pharmacy Technician Program:

- · Is an 8-12 month program, including required full-time clinical externship.
- The course prepares graduates to sit for industry certification exams such as the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) and the exam for the Certification of Pharmacy Technicians (ExCPT).

Requirements for the Pharmacy Technician Program include:

- Referred by a member in good standing of SEIU-UHW
- 18 years of age or older, able to work in the U.S., and a resident of California
- · Completed high school diploma or GED
- Computer and internet proficiency with home access to consistent, reliable high-speed internet and a reliable, working computer or laptop
- Willing to commit 3-5 hours per day (estimated at 20+ hours per week) of study time
- Complete Human Touch Jump Start Course prior to starting the program
- Ability to pass both a drug screen and background check with no felony convictions
