

Future Student Checklist

- ☐ Has been referred by an SEIU-UHW member. Make sure you have their full name, phone number, last 4 digits of their employer number, and facility.
 - ☐ If referred by a Healthcare Justice member have their name and phone number on record.
- ☐ Has a computer or laptop, or consistent access to one with software capable of handling online platforms.
- ☐ Has reliable high-speed internet access.
- ☐ Has a plan to be able to commit 3-4 hours to complete online course work.
- ☐ Has flexibility to take time off to complete the required 4-6 week MA externship.
- ☐ Has reliable transportation to labs.
- ☐ Has up to date immunizations including Covid Vaccine at student's expense.
- ☐ Can pass both a drug screen and background check with no felony convictions (a cost between\$77-\$119).
- ☐ Is 18 years of age or older, able to work in the U.S., a resident of California, and has High school diploma or GED.
- ☐ Has a debit or credit card to cover the \$50 registration fee for the **Human Touch Jumpstart Course** and \$100 registration. fee for the MA Program, once accepted.

To start the MA program, students must first pass the Jump Start: Human Touch Healthcare Course.

- Learn the soft skills essential for patient care that will make you stand out to employers.
- The **free course** is 8 weeks and 100% online.
- Mandatory weekly, one-hour live virtual sessions led by course facilitators.
